### *Protecting your passwords*

Your password may be compromised if you view multiple sign-in failures on your account, if another account that you use the same or a similar password to has been accessed by someone else, or if you notice strange activity on your account. If your password has been compromised, all of the data it leads to has also been compromised. It's very important to change your password if you believe that someone else has accessed your account. Make sure that your new password is completely unique.
