Individual entering facilities as an investigative journalist filming, citing First Amendment rights

Recently, an individual has been entering South Carolina hospitals with a camera as an investigative journalist claiming he has a First Amendment right to film in the facility. As a health care organization, our goal is to protect the privacy of our patients, team members and visitors at all times. No one is allowed to film without proper authorization, regardless of what reason they give.
