Tracking contents of a sexual assault kit through DNA

The number of sexual assault cases has increased in Greenville County and the surrounding Upstate with overwhelming need for proper collection and preservation of forensic evidence. To meet this need, the Prisma Health–Upstate Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Program was created and responds to cases at all Prisma Health–Upstate hospital facilities. The South Carolina legislature is now considering a bill involving the tracking of rape kits (these kits provide forensic evidence for potential prosecution). *Note: GHS and Palmetto Health have joined to become Prisma Health.*

This FREE seminar addresses what is inside those evidence collection boxes, the likelihood of obtaining DNA and why a backlog exists. This need-to-know Information will be presented in an easy-to-understand way that is not specific to medical professionals, but for the entire community.
