About the Program

- The Neonatal Developmental Program (NDP) is offered by the Department of Developmental Pediatrics at Children's Hospital of Greenville Health System
- This program is designed to monitor and support the development of newborn infants who have been identified as at risk for having developmental problems

Program Goals

- To provide developmental evaluation that gives parents information about their child's development and his or her unique strengths and needs
- To assist families in connecting with medical and community resources including primary care physicians (i.e., "regular" doctors), healthcare providers, developmental therapists and other related agencies (e.g., BabyNet, school districts, etc.)
- To educate parents about the course of expected development and ways to promote optimal development.
- To promote good relationships between infants and their caregivers

We offer teams of a variety of professionals. Teams may include any of the following: developmental pediatricians, fellows and residents, neonatologists, nurse practitioners, physical therapists/occupational therapists, psychologists, nurses and social workers.
