

What to expect at your next well check at The Children's Clinic

- 2 months: Pediarix (Hepatitis B, DTaP, and Polio vaccines)
Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type b)
Pevnar (pneumococcal vaccine)
Rotarix (rotavirus vaccine)
- 4 months: Pediarix

- 6 months: Pediarix

- 9 months: Hemoglobin (finger stick)
- 12 months: Pevnar
Varivax (Chickenpox vaccine)
Hepatitis A
- 15 months: DTaP
MMR

- 18 months: Hepatitis A (six months after first dose)
- 2 years: Hib booster if needed
Hemoglobin
- 3 years: Hemoglobin
Blood pressure, urinalysis (urine specimen in a cup- if able)
- 4 years: Kinrix (DTaP and polio vaccines)
MMR
Varivax
Blood pressure, urinalysis
Vision screen
- 5 years: Varivax booster if needed
Hemoglobin
Blood pressure, urinalysis
Vision screen, hearing screen (optional)
- 6 years & up: Hemoglobin
Blood pressure, urinalysis
Vision screen
- 11 years: Boostrix (Tdap vaccine)
Menactra (Meningococcal meningitis vaccine)
Girls only: Gardasil (HPV vaccine) optional; given in three doses over six months
Varivax booster if needed

Note: This schedule is subject to change according to the doctor's specification and the individual needs of the child.
