Bronchoscopy/Mediastinoscopy

- Mild throat discomfort, hoarseness and coughing small amounts of blood are all common after this procedure. They should subside within 24 to 48 hours.
- Call our office if you have any of the following problems:
 - Increasing shortness of breath
 - Worsening chest pain
 - Increasing amounts of bleeding from coughing
 - Swelling around your face or neck
 - Fever that lasts more than 24 hours
- Your throat may feel numb from the medication you are taking. This medicine may leave a bitter taste in your mouth. Be careful drinking and eating until the medicine has worn off to make sure you don't choke.

Remember to wash hands to prevent the spread of germs.

You will receive a follow-up phone call in one to three days after surgery from the Outpatient Recovery department.
