Penile skin bridges

Penile skin bridges are when a band of tissue forms from the shaft to the head of the penis following a circumcision. These attachments are thicker than penile adhesions and will not separate on their own and cannot be teased apart. A procedure called penile skin bridge lysis can be performed to divide the skin bridge either in our office or under anesthesia to treat this issue.
